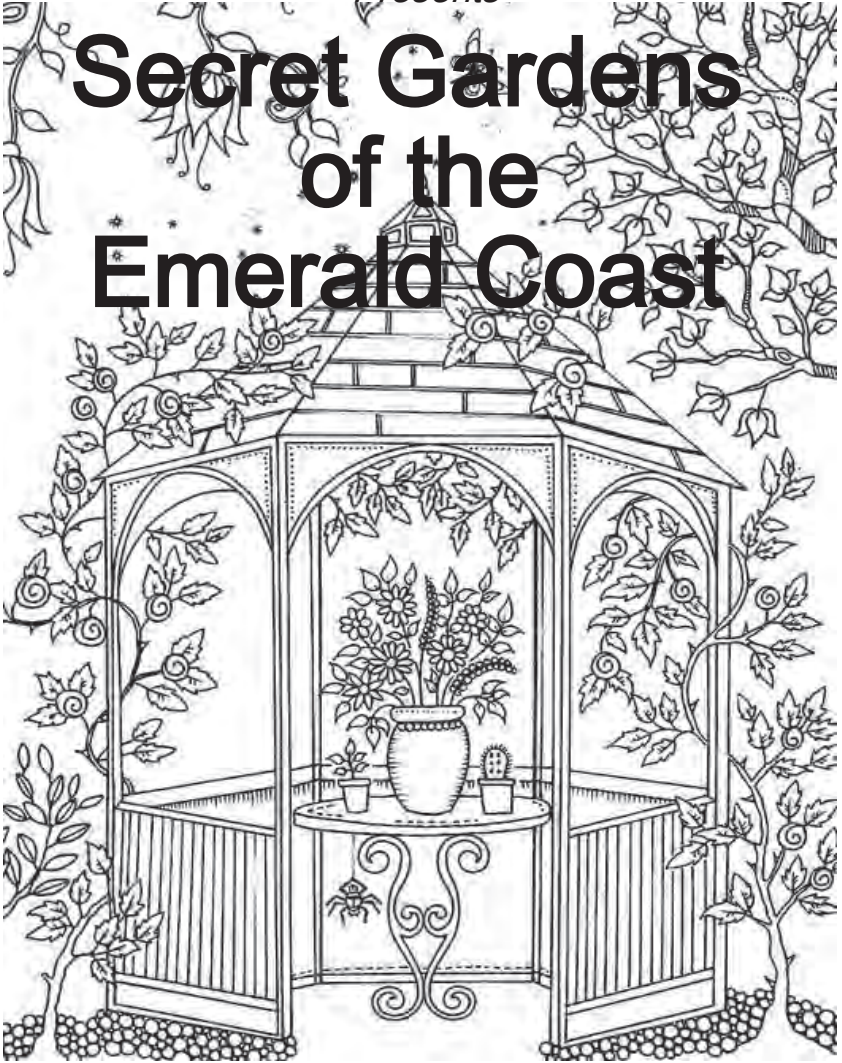

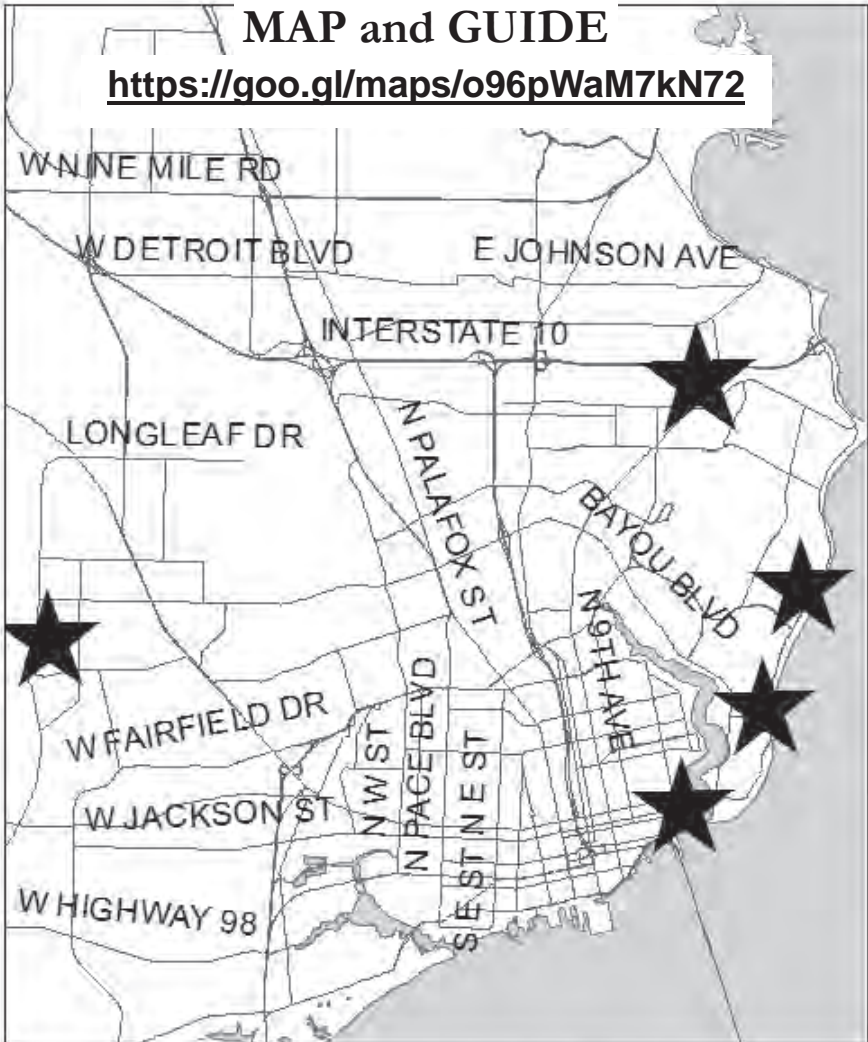

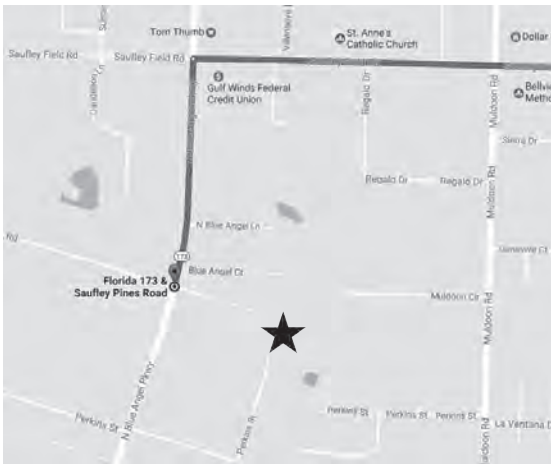

### Directions and Parking Instructions

The driveway to this garden is .03 miles south of Sauflley Field Road on Blue Angel Pkwy across from Sauflley Pines Road. Look for the old red truck with its bed full of flowers at the driveway. **DO NOT** follow the online mapping instructions and try to enter via Perkins St. The following link will get you to the entrance to this garden. <https://goo.gl/maps/wcy7AsrVdxv>

The Barnards have lived on the property 19 years and have planted a lot of the trees and bushes over the years. The property includes a greenhouse, potting shed, raised vegetable beds surrounded by old concrete street markers from downtown Pensacola, and a flower garden next to the chicken-and-peacock barn. They have a great bird feeding station where the chickens eat all of the seeds that visiting birds knock out. The property includes a pond, a wetland area, and a wooded trail. There are many large, old live oaks and other types of trees. The flower garden is four years old and is planted for the pollinators and nectar-drinkers—butterflies, bees, and hummingbirds. Passion vine, cypress vine, citrus trees, milkweed, fennel, parsley and dill are some of the host plants for butterflies. Furthermore, there is a good variety of flowering plants to keep the butterflies happy.

The owners have repurposed items salvaged from demolition jobs, including many old/antique items from around Pensacola that are placed throughout the property.

A natural wonderland, the Barnard garden is certified by the National Wildlife Federation.

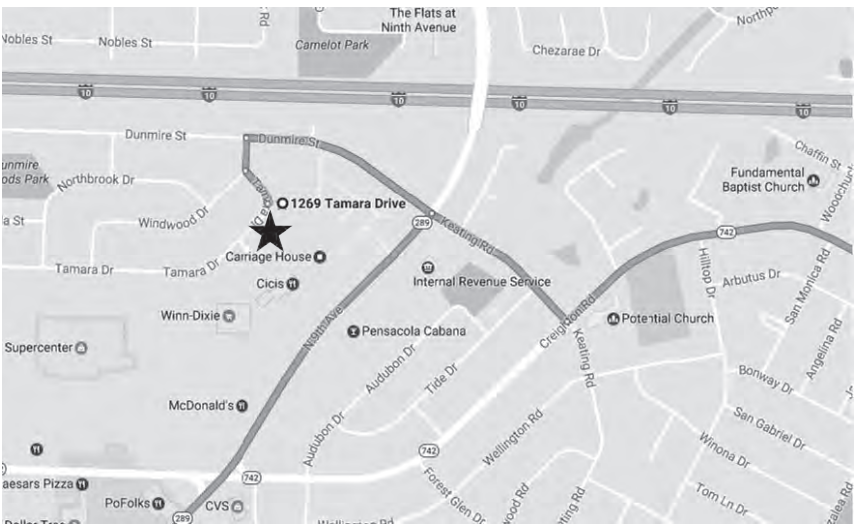

## Garden #2

### Directions and Parking Instructions

Exit right on to Blue Angel Parkway and head north. At Saufley Field Rd (Rt 296) turn right. Travel all the way to 9th Ave. At the intersection by Sacred Heart Hospital, turn left on to 9th Ave. You will go past the Cordova Mall on your right. Stay on 9th, crossing over Langley and Creighton roads. Proceed .5 miles past Creighton and take a left at the next light (Dunmire and Keating intersection). Turn left onto Winwood Dr (Dunmire Woods Subdivision). Turn left on Tamara Dr, and the garden will be on the right. Proceed the safest way out of the subdivision (see map inset).

There are many appealing features in this relaxed and relaxing butterfly-friendly garden. On the right side of the front yard, there is a shade garden under the live oak. In the shade bed reside aucuba and pieris, and in the front bed the owners have placed a sago palm, a satsuma orange, and lots of butterfly nectar plants. The variety of cut flowers and lilies were chosen with the object of having something blooming from February to October.

On the left is a gathering of several varieties of lilies. A nice cassia attracts yellow sulfur butterflies, while across the back passion vines entice gulf fritillaries. A burgundy plum tree is placed in a nice sunny spot to produce some delicious fruit. Almost everywhere there is some variety of milkweed for monarch butterflies.

The brick path on the other side of the driveway around the utility side of the house leads to the back gate. This area is kept with low maintenance plants as well as growth that tends to stay green. In many places in the yard, shepherd's hooks have been installed, most sunk in concrete and adapted to be part of the water delivery system.

Those passing through the gate are greeted by Persian shield at their feet and the white garden bed on the right. Close observers throughout the yard will be rewarded by elements looking back at them. Many backyard favorites include nice specimens of holly fern, yesterday today and tomorrow, and weeping yaupon holly line the path to the pond where one can have a seat and enjoy the music of the flowing water. Across the pond, under a unique live oak specimen, a variety of foliage shapes and textures enrich the view. On the right next to the pond we have prickly leaf mahonia with the blue berries, next to split-leaf

philodendron ... next to a fatsia ... next to a southern wood fern ... next to a tractor seat. All are surrounded with different kinds of ferns, irises, and colocasias (elephant ears).

Around the back yard, in front of the green house, are many kinds of butterfly nectar plants and an arbor with two kinds of muscadine grapes. Through the arbor is a stand of clump bamboo performing a visual blocking maneuver, hiding the maintenance area for the pond and the compost pile.

The Norman yard is focused on serenity and is a sanctuary for most critters who choose to visit them. They welcome the butterflies, birds, bees, snakes, turtles and almost anything else that chooses to visit, eat, drink, or rest with them. The only unwelcome visitor to date has been a blue heron, but the introduction of their bouncer, Larry, has discouraged a return visit. Relax and enjoy, and thank you for visiting.

Go back to Dunmire Rd, and at the light at 9th Ave, proceed



straight across to Keating Rd which will intersect with Creighton. Take a left on Creighton and head east to Scenic Hwy. Garden # 3 is approximately 8 min or 4.5 miles. You will pass the turnoff to Langley Ave. At Brookshire Drive, turn right into the Bay Cliffs subdivision. Turn right on Montaigne, and take the 3rd left onto Chastain Way. The garden is the first house on the left (not the corner house).

Glenn Schulman  
3585 Chastain Way**

Glenn's rose garden does not look like a typical garden-variety garden! He grows roses to enter into competition at rose shows throughout the South. His rose garden is comprised of about a dozen raised beds with the rose bushes planted approximately three feet apart. Glenn is a pharmacist by profession, and he employs his pharmaceutical knowledge to stock a garden shed with chemicals, fertilizers, and various natural materials to help his roses grow.

He has an irrigation system that delivers precise amounts of water and fertilizer using a drip method, thus avoiding overhead watering that promotes fungal diseases. Each plant is staked up, even though the canes on his roses are so thick that they hardly seem to need support. Glenn grows hybrid tea roses exclusively and has been winning awards with them for a couple of decades. There are times when he will methodically remove buds from a plant until he has only the best one or two remaining to receive the full nourishment from the entire plant to grow into an exhibition-class rose.

In one corner of his garden is a "misting box," which delivers small mists of water every few minutes during the day. In

this box, he propagates new roses from cuttings off mature plants. He is one of the Pensacola Rose Society members who propagates out-of-patent roses for sale by the society and for his own use.



The front yard of the Frost home and garden is centered by a cascading fountain with the circular drive around it. A riot of color results from roses, petunias, blue salvia, society garlic, verbena, agapanthus, begonias, and other plants surrounding the water feature.

On the right side of the driveway stand two large Bradford pear trees and a cherry blossom tree, underlain by *Cleyera japonica* and Encore azaleas. Deep blue salvia line the east fence, along with numerous varieties of interest-catching multicolored foliage on the way into the backyard through the wrought iron gate.

Facing the house are graceful curved, raised stonework beds filled with coral verbena, daisies, knockout roses, a large sago palm, holly bushes, and shrimp plant. Bordering the lawn in front of the large, inviting porch and pergola are more knockout roses and gerbera daisies. Next to the stone pathway leading to the front door, the eye is drawn by a lovely mature Japanese maple tree underplanted with tiny purple and white alyssum. Also in this bed is a sasanqua camellia next to the house, pink guara, pink

knock out roses, lilies, another large sago, a crepe myrtle tree, and several cleyera bushes.

On the left side of the driveway is a redbud tree, lavender and white lantana, Aztec grass, azaleas, ginger, a “yesterday, today, tomorrow” plant, and miniature gardenias, along with many other trees and shrubs typically found in northwest Florida. To the left of the house is another gate leading into the back yard.

The backyard garden features a swimming pool, a large wood deck curving around the sunroom of the home, and a lovely cascading waterfall into a fish pond. Plates acquired on travels enjoyed by the homeowners in recent years have been integrated into the stonework of the waterfall. Encompassing the outskirts of the pool area are more stonework raised beds containing various plantings of trees, shrubs, annual and perennial flowers, and caladiums. The wooded area at the back of the yard has been left in a natural state for the owners to enjoy occasional campfires with their grandchildren.

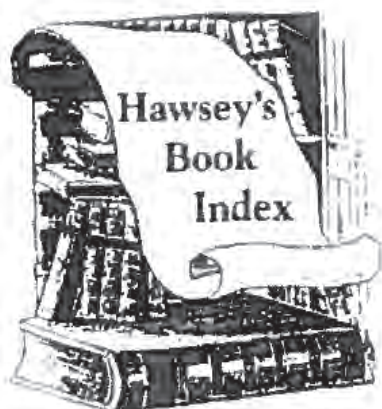

The goal for the owners of this East Hill residence is to create a traditional landscape of mainly indigenous plants in a residential neighborhood. Being named as the Residential Garden for the Longleaf Pine Chapter of the Florida Native Plant Society means that they have succeeded.

Over the last ten years, this East Hill residence has been transformed into a mostly Florida native plant landscape. Arriving you will notice the large drifts of the native *Serenoa repens* (saw palmetto) interlaced with *Ilex vomitoria* (yaupon holly) and over 25 large *Cercis canadensis* (redbud trees).

Our tour starts on the west side of the house with the registration table under the porte-cochère. Blocking the street view is a hedge row of *Forestiera segregata* (native Florida privet), a highly salt-tolerant evergreen shrub that has small fragrant flowers that attract pollinators followed by abundant dark berries for birds. Just outside the kitchen door is the herb garden full of assorted peppers, herbs, blueberries, and a Meyer lemon tree.

By the edge of the pool sits a pot of *Hydrocotyle bonariensis* (pennywort or dollar weed). This often abhorred celery relative is equally edible tossed with salads or cooked. It holds its own as a graphic, almost architectural, element when grown as a specimen plant.

To the side of the pool house, one step down leads into the butterfly/pollinator garden. This garden showcases many blooming native plants as well as a variety of citrus and fig trees. Be sure to seek out the *Silene regia* (royal catchfly), an endangered member of the pink family and a hummingbird favorite.

Passage through the double metal gates is rewarded with a greeting by a milkweed meadow, a favorite of monarch butterflies. This side yard garden features many varieties of native rhododendron azaleas, *Prunus angustiflora* (Chickasaw plum), *Ilex glabra* (gallberry), chokeberry, and many blueberries. The spicebush swallowtail butterflies and caterpillars may be seen on the *Lindera benzoin* (spicebush).

The front of the house is flanked with two large specimen Japanese red maples used as non-native accents. A *Cliftonia monophyllia* 'Vanceleave' (rare pink titi tree) is also a front yard must-see.

By making the planting beds larger, lawn turf areas were drastically reduced to just six-foot wide strips along the streets and small areas near the front sidewalk. The owners plant annual rye grass each year for 8 months of green turf, which then dies back in the heat of summer. Whatever wants to grow the other four months is permitted and mowed. Be sure to see the plot of the ornamental rhizomal perennial peanut *Arachis glabrata*. Known as Ecoturf, this sod offers true drought tolerance, no known pests, no need for supplemental nitrogen or phosphorous fertilizer, and requires very little mowing--all of this in an aesthetically attractive hardy plant with green foliage and beautiful yellow-orange flowers!

While most plants in this landscape are labeled, members of the Longleaf Pine Chapter of the Florida Native Plant Society will be on hand to answer questions and give details about native plants.

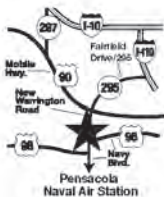

The Pensacola Federation of Garden Clubs is grateful to prominent Pensacola residents Rishy and Quint Studer to be able to include their professionally designed and maintained residential gardens on our Secret Garden Tour this year. Their garden design consultant, René J. L. Fransen, recalls . . .

When I arrived at the Studer residence, basic maintenance had not occurred in years. There were two highly dangerous goat-trails made out of the stones that had been brought to the site when the house was completed in 1932. These stepping stones leading down the hill were not necessarily flat. Many camellias were in evidence, as the Pensacola Chapter of the Camellia Society was initiated at this residence.

It was Quint Studer's vision to have places to sit and rest, and to enjoy the view as one ascends or descends towards Bayou Texar. There was a pump house that furnished water to an overgrown and cracked waterfall that had bones that could still be vaguely observed. I went to the Pensacola Historical Society to see if they had photos or a written description of this feature, but there was nothing on record.

On my initial visit to interview for the job, I told Rishy and Quint Studer to buy the lot next door whether they hired me or not. They did so, and Quint's request was to keep everything separate on 1919 and 1911 East LaRua. 1919 East LaRua was a northern house built in a southern climate. In order to relate the house better to the garden, the long room had French doors added that are on axis with a lead-bowl, tiered fountain. A balcony off of the master bedroom's sitting room was added to give the Studers a place to have coffee and enjoy their spectacular view.

The garden was created to show off unique plants. These include giant ligularia (leopard plants), which is the featured plant in this garden that helps create its uniqueness. Visitors will also find Japanese ardesia, tree-form Zhou Zhu loropetalum, tree-form pineapple guava, Australian tree-fern, false indigo, olives, pink weeping tree-form hibiscus, bromeliads, fatsia, green aucuba, boxwood balls, and an assortment of hydrangea, including Endless Summer, variegated, and oakleaf. Also on site are three weeping bald cypress.

A master plan was developed that made the fountain the focal point of the entry-court to 1919 LaRua, off the long room that still looks out on the original Pink Perfection and Purple Dawn camellias that were planted in the 1930s. A

pavilion was planned at the bottom of the curved steps that allowed the trees to remain, and a new waterfall was installed. A pool and a modest pool-house were planned for 1911 LaRua, with the modest pool-house ultimately expanding into a three-bedroom pool/guesthouse. A tower was determined to be the most efficient way to get up and down on the 1911 LaRua property. It has rocks in the lower level to match the large waterfall, and mini-waterfalls occur as water features of the swimming pool.

Pennsylvania blue select thermal flagstone is used on most of the paving and steps. Indiana limestone to match the house was used in various places to tie the new construction to the original house at 1919 LaRua, built in 1932. The old driveway was replaced, and the properties connect where the driveways connect to each other. The garden was designed so many surprises exist.
